

# **PREPARATION**



All stock hardware will be re-used.

- 1. Remove the stock windshield. (T25 and T40 Torx)
- 2. Remove the Windshield Swivel Mount point to expose square nut. (T40) Figure 1
- 3. Place Spacer from Bag #987 over nut. Figure 2
- 4. Reinstall Windshield Swivel Mount. (T40) Figure 2



# **INSTALLATION**

- 1. Insert one spacer (6) into each of the round mount holes in the VStream windshield.
- 2. Place VStream Windshield on original mount points.
- 3. Loosely install the 4 upper screws (a). (T25) Figure 3
- 4. At point (b) assembly hardware as shown in figure 4. (T25)

From inside of windshield insert Top Hat Bushing (3) into hole with flat of Bushing against headlight housing.

Place Flat Washer (5) to outside of Windshield.

Loosely secure with Screw (4) supplied in Bag 987.

- 5. Loosely install the Swivel Mount Screw (c). (T40) Figure 3
- 6. Adjust Windshield. Figure 5
- **7.** Tighten all hardware including the inside screw on the Swivel Mount Bracket. **(T25 and T40) Figure 6**

# **MAINTENANCE**

Cleaning: Wash with a clean soft cloth, plenty of warm water and, if necessary, a non-abrasive soap such as dishwashing liquid. Flannel or soft chamois make good cleaning cloths. Do not use rain protective products on the screen due to the solvent action of the alcohol in these products. Do not allow brake fluid, alcohol, or strong solvents to contact the screen.

National Cycle Windshield Wash Part number N1401 is recommended for everyday cleaning. Product is supplied with a handy travel size container and rag for easy storage on the motorcycle.
