

PREPARATION and REMOVAL OF PARTS

1. Remove the stock guard. Parts will not be re-used. Figure 1 and Figure 2. (T25 Torx Wrench)







INSTALLATION

- 1. Apply a small amount of Loctite thread locker onto the ends of the $M5 \times 16$ screws (2).
- 2. Place the ZTechnik Tire Huggr into position and secure with screws and washers as shown in figure 3. (T-25 Torx Wrench) Figure 3
- 3. Place the Nylon Clamp around the cable. Secure to the Hugger using the Nylon Screw and Nut from Bag #1004. (Flat Blade Screw Driver) Figure 4
- 4. Tighten all screws firmly.

MAINTENANCE

To clean the Chain Guard, wash with a clean soft cloth, plenty of warm water and if necessary, a non-abrasive soap such as dishwashing liquid.
