

VStream Windshield, Quantum Coated Lexan® polycarbonate 1

INSTALLATION



Retain all fasteners, as they will be reused.

- 1. Remove the 4 screws holding the outside plates on stock windshield. (Torx Wrench, T25)
- 2. Remove the 2 screws holding the stock windscreen to the mounts. (Torx Wrench, T25)
- **3.** Place the ZTechnik VStream Windscreen into position on the stock windscreen mounts. Reinstall the original bolts through the windscreen and into the mounts. **(Torx Wrench, T25)**
- 4. Tighten the bolts firmly. (Torx Wrench, T25)
- **5.** Reinstall the stock outside plates onto your new VStream using stock screws. **(Torx Wrench, T25)**

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning: Wash with a clean soft cloth, plenty of warm water and, if necessary, a non-abrasive soap such as dishwashing liquid. Flannel or soft chamois make good cleaning cloths.

Paint, glue residue removal: Moisten cotton with a small amount of Naphtha or Turpentine followed by a wash as above. Do not clean polycarbonate in hot sun or high temperatures. Do not clean the screen with glass cleaners. Do not use rain protective products on the screen. The solvent action of the alcohol in these products will destroy the screen. Do not allow brake fluid, alcohol, or strong solvents to contact the screen.
