

### **INSTALLATION**

Retain all fasteners, as they will be reused.
To facilitate reassembly, note the orientation of Covers and Bracket as you remove them in steps 1 and 2.

- 1. Carefully remove the two covers on outside of stock windshield.
- **2.** Remove the four screws that hold the bracket and stock windscreen in place. Store stock windscreen it will not be reused.
- 3. Place your VStream Windscreen into position and install to motorcycle using the original screws, brackets and covers.
- 5. Tighten the bolts firmly. Do not over tighten. (3mm Allan Wrench)

## **MAINTENANCE**

**Cleaning:** Wash with a clean soft cloth, plenty of warm water and, if necessary, a non-abrasive soap such as dishwashing liquid. Flannel or soft chamois make good cleaning cloths.

Paint, glue residue removal: Moisten cotton with a small amount of Naphtha or Turpentine followed by a wash as above. Do not clean polycarbonate in hot sun or high temperatures. Do not clean the screen with glass cleaners. Do not use rain protective products on the screen. The solvent action of the alcohol in these products will destroy the screen. Do not allow brake fluid, alcohol, or strong solvents to contact the screen.
