 N76602 Chrome Lower are engineered to install to a National Cycle QuickSet 4 Mount Kit Q301. You must have this Mount Kit (SwitchBlade windshield mount kit) mounted on your motorcycle or have purchased this kit prior to installing the Chrome Lower.

 When mounting the chrome lowers re-use all hardware from your QuickSet 4 Mount Kit.



Proper tightening of this assembly is critical. Use a Torque Wrench! Follow this procedure! Correct assembly of this kit will provide years of reliable service.

### PREPARATION


1. Locate the Installation Manual 10-112208-000 from the QuickSet 4 Mount Kit. If you no longer have this manual go to: [www.nationalcycle.com/support.html](http://www.nationalcycle.com/support.html) to locate the manual.

2. Position the motorcycle securely on its stand or a work stand.

3. Cover the front fender and fuel tank with a suitable cloth to avoid scratches from dropped tools.

4. If you have a QuickSet 4 Mount Kit on the motorcycle, remove the Kit (**5mm Hex Key**).

5. Remove the small Lower Spool from the Mount Bracket (**4mm Hex Key**). **Figure 1**

 All Hardware will be re-used.

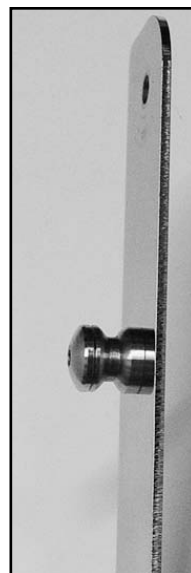

## INSTALLATION of N76602

1. Push the large Upper Cap Bushing into the large Upper Spool so the **thick side** of the spool is near the head of the Upper Cap Bushing. **Figure 2**

2. Repeat for the Lower Spool. **Figure 3**

3. Select the right side Chrome Lower and right side Mount Bracket.

4. Apply Thread Lock to stud on Mount Bracket. Assemble the Chrome Lower To the Mount Bracket with Small Spool assembly. **Figure 4**

5. Install the right side Chrome Lower assembly to the right side of the motorcycle. Start the M8-40 Screw from Kit Q301 through the Upper Spool assembly, the Chrome Lower Bracket assembly, Bushing and then into the upper hole in fork (**5mm Hex Key**). **Figure 5**

6. Install the lower M8-16 Screw (**5mm Hex Key**). **Figure 5**

7. Repeat steps 1 through 6 on left fork.



8. Tighten M8 Screws to 15 ft/lbs (21Nm). Tighten the small Lower Spool to 50 INCH POUNDS (5.7 Nm) (4.17ft/lbs) (Torque Wrench).

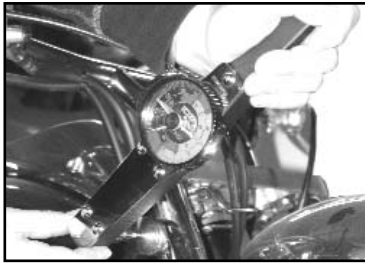

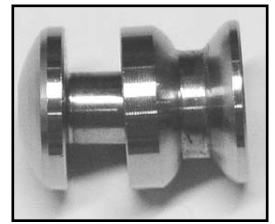

the Cap Bushing.*

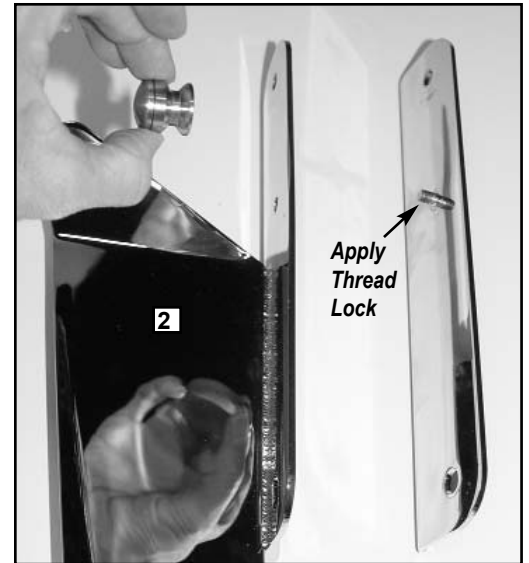

*Mount Bracket*

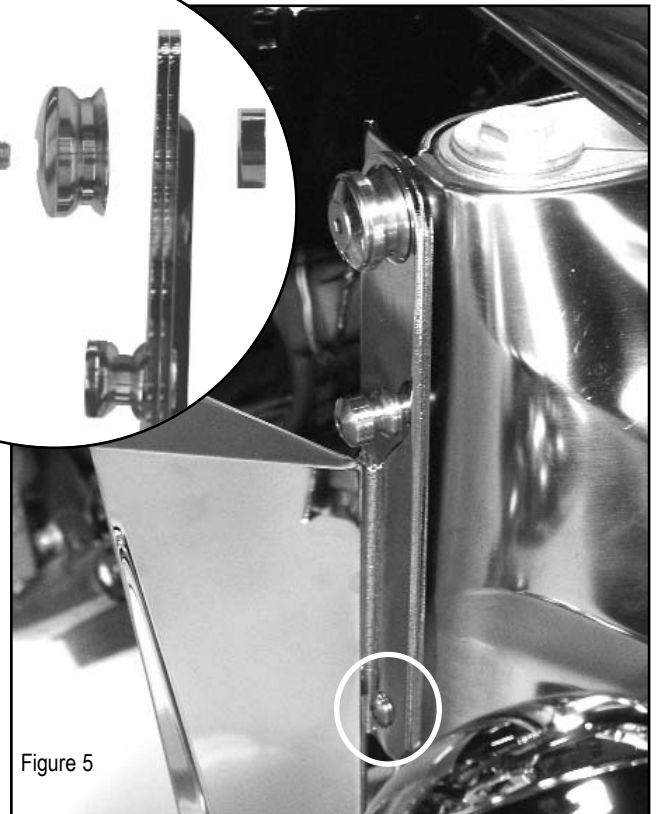
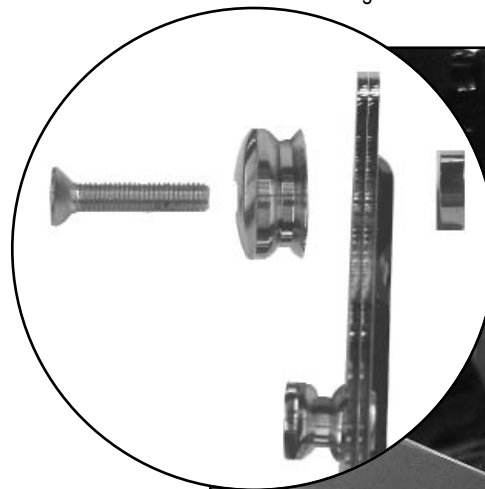

## MAINTENANCE

The high quality chrome finish of your National Cycle Chrome Lower can be maintained with any quality chrome cleaner and / or polish applied with a soft cloth.

Check hardware for tightness regularly. Never ride with loose mounting hardware. Check to be sure your Chrome Lower do not contact any part of the motorcycle at a full turn left and right. Correct any problem before using the motorcycle.
