PREPARATION and REMOVAL OF PARTS

1. Remove the stock chain guard. Parts will not be re-used. Figure 1 (T25 Torx Wrench)

INSTALLATION

1. Angle the ZTechnik Chain Guard as shown in figure 2 and slip the chain guard between side cover and wheel.

2. Remove the screws from Bag #1003 and apply a small amount of Loctite thread locker onto the end of each screw.

3. Install the Chain Guard using the screws and washers from Bag #1003. Washer is placed on the INSIDE of the Guard. **Figure 3 (T25 Torx Wrench)**

4. Tighten screws firmly.
